

Clayton County Public Schools SY21-22 Operational Game Plan

PPE and Safety Guidelines



- Students and employees will be **required** to wear a mask in all CCPS buildings.
- Social distancing of 3 feet will be encouraged when possible.
- Temperature checks for all employees, students, and visitors will be conducted in all CCPS facilities.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided in all classrooms.
- Desk shields will be provided in all elementary classrooms and in all low-incidence special education classrooms.
- All high-touch points will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Staff screening procedures will be required in all CCPS facilities.
- Isolation Rooms & COVID Response Teams will remain in all schools.
- Custodians will sanitize school buildings daily.

Visitors to the Building



- CCPS Employees will be able to visit buildings. They will be required to wear a mask and will complete the CCPS COVID Pre-screener prior to entering the building.
- Visitors will be allowed to visit schools on the first two days of school. All visitors will be asked to wear a mask and practice the district's other COVID-19 safety guidelines/procedures (e.g. social distancing & complete the COVID pre-screener).
- After day two, visitors will be allowed in the school buildings by appointment only and will be required to wear a mask and follow the district's safety protocols.
- Virtual meetings with parents will be encouraged.

Nutrition Services



- Schools will utilize the traditional breakfast and lunch schedule.
- Students will be required to wear a mask when not eating.
- Cafeteria tables will be cleaned & disinfected between meals.
- Virtual Learning Program (VLP) students will be provided an opportunity to pick up meals at schools. There will be separate breakfast and lunch pick up times. Confirm the pick up times at each school location.
- During the Extended Learning Beyond the Classroom (ELBC) days, meals will be delivered in the community via school buses.

Transportation



- Buses will be at full capacity.
- Students will be required to wear masks.
- Students will have assigned seats by the bus driver.
- Buses will be cleaned and sanitized between each route.
- Parents can utilize [WebQuery](#) to obtain students' route and bus stop information.
- Parents can obtain information on route delays using "Bus Tracker" on the district's Transportation Website.

Procedures for Large Gatherings



- Open House will be virtual on July 29th - Grades K-5 (1-3 p.m.), Grades 6-8 (3-5 p.m.) & Grades 9-12 (5-7 p.m.).
- School assemblies, programs, and large group meetings will be virtual.
- Students can participate in recess and large group outdoor activities.
- Students will attend Specials and Connections.
- Outdoor athletic venues will have unlimited seating, and a limited number of guests will be allowed in school gymnasiums.

Field Trips



- Students will adhere to the district's protocols (wear masks, use hand sanitizer, and participate in temperature checks) before and during field trips.
- School personnel will chaperone all field trips.
- Field trips that require high touch and have minimal ventilation within the venue will not be permitted, such as skating rinks and bowling alleys.
- Seating charts will be required for the bus during all field trips.

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Instructional



- Students will have assigned seats in all classrooms.
- Students will be expected to have their own supplies.
- Teachers will minimize the sharing of instructional resources and lab equipment - when feasible.
- Ongoing sanitization of highly-used and high-touched areas.
- Virtual Learning is for pre-approved school-based Virtual Learning Program students only. These students will be provided a Chromebook for instructional use.
- At home ELBC Learning Days for all students:
August 27th, September 17th, October 8th, October 29th, November 19th, January 28th, February 25th, March 11th, and April 1st

General



- All students will attend school daily, Monday-Friday, following the regular school schedule.
 - ES 7:45 a.m. - 2:15 p.m.
 - MS 8:45 a.m. - 3:45 p.m.
 - HS 8:20 a.m. - 3:15 p.m.
- In person registration will be available at all schools from July 20th-30th.
- Elementary and Middle school students will wear uniforms.
- All students must have an updated immunization form on file at their school
- Lockers will be optional for secondary students.
- Book bags will be placed in lockers upon entry to the school (Middle and High Schools).
- Campus Kids will be offered.

Technology



- Students in grades 3-12 will have 1:1 Chromebooks.
- Students in grades PreK-2 will have access to a laptop in their classrooms.
- New students and students in grades 3, 6, & 9 will receive Chromebooks on the first day of school. All other grade levels will retain their Chromebook from the previous year.
- Students must bring charged Chromebooks to school daily.
- Virtual Learning Program students will be issued a Chromebook at their homeschool site.
- Students are encouraged to have headphones daily.

Athletics



- Ensure all student-athletes have updated documentation in the DragonFly platform.
- Required documents for participation:
 - COVID Waiver
 - Pre-participation Physical Form
 - Concussion Awareness Form
 - Sudden Cardiac Arrest Awareness
 - CCPS Insurance Waiver
 - Heat & Illness Awareness Form
- Inside athletic events will require masks.
- There are no restrictions for outdoor athletic events.
- Equipment and Locker Rooms are sanitized after each use using sprayers/methods provided.
- Middle school football will begin July 26, 2021 and all other sports will begin August 1, 2021.
- High school athletics will continue as scheduled.

All processes and procedures will be reassessed as needed.
